Yesterday marked an important step in rebuilding stability following the upheavals of Brexit and Covid: the announcement of the multi-year comprehensive spending review, alongside an Autumn Budget. On the face of it, museums and heritage have done reasonably well in an environment with high demand for spending. As usual, much of the cultural spending comes in the form of capital but we're pleased to see an extension to the Museums and Galleries Exhibition Tax Relief and we expect AIM members to be helped by business rates discount for retail, hospitality and leisure.
