Two part training course



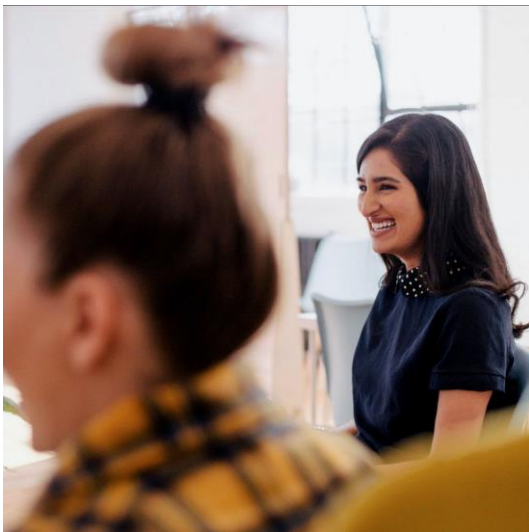
